## How to pack your 'Box of Joy'

- Take any old shoe box or any gift box (if you don't have a shoe box).
- Wrap the box but remember to wrap the lid separately.

You can be as creative as you want. The wrapping paper can be designed by you and your child or made with recycled paper. Remember, it is a gift for a child. Please decorate it to make it look special.

3 Pack useful and educational materials in the box. Please include **new** materials and not used and old toys.

## Some ideas of what to pack:

- a. Useful things water bottles, pencil boxes, note pads, caps, raincoat, school bags, crayons, pencils, erasers, correction pens, diapers, blankets, milk bottles etc.
- b. Health and hygiene toothbrush, toiletries, soap etc.
- c. Toys stuffed toys, board games, cars, dolls, wooden educational toys, rattles, balls, construction blocks, small musical instruments etc.
- d. Educational resources colouring books, books, scientific calculators, mechanical pencils, curved rulers and mathematical sets, jig saw puzzles etc.

Please ensure that if you pack battery operated toys, the batteries are fresh and not leaking. No liquids, medicines or food items should be packed. No dangerous items like scissors, guns, razors and aerosols should be packed.

Once your beautiful box is ready, drop them off at any EtonHouse school and we will do the rest.
